singular, my undivided one half interest in all those four pieces, parcels and tracts of land situate, lying and being one in Grant and three in Great Townships in the county of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, said to contain Two hundred and fifty eight acres, Forty eight acres, Three hundred acres, and three hundred and eighty four acres more or less, respectively, in the aggregate containing nine hundred and ninety acres being the same interest possessed to me by Mr W Gilreath the deced of my deceased husband late of the County of Jefferson in the State of Alabama by deed of purchase bearing date the 25th day of January A.D. 1896, and recorded in Vol G.C. page 193, R.M.C. office in and for the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina to which reference is made for a more particular description except a tract of one hundred acres sold off to Garrison which was conveyed to him by the said Burbage and Julia M Gilreath and is not intended to be included in this deed of purchase.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel P Burbage and his Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
