KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

we, Mary V. Sullivan, and Henrietta E. Gaines of the County of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum  
of Twenty-two hundred Dollars to us in hand paid at  
and before the sealing of these presents by Lillie M. Hunter of said County and state  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said Lillie M. Hunter all our right, title and  
interest both at law and in equity to and in that cer-  
tain tract of land situate in Greenville County in  
State aforesaid on both sides of Horsepen Creek containing  
eight hundred and ninety-five acres, more or less bounded  
by lands of T.R. League, Clayton Kilgore, Mrs. H.G. Gaines  
and others. Our interest in said land being derived under  
the will Josiah Kilgore deceased of record in the office of  
the Probate Judge for said County filed in 1855 and being an  
estate equal to two-thirds of the whole in fee in remain-  
der after death of Mary K. Stokel, deceased. We having elected  
to take our interest in the land itself rather than in the  
proceeds of sale, and this being intended to cover our  
entire interest in said land and the proceeds of sale  
thereof. This shall not operate to merge with any other estate  
already or hereafter acquired by the said Lillie M. Hunter in  
said lands, but the same shall remain open, separate,  
and distinct.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any-  
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Lillie M. Hunter  
her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves and our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Lillie M. Hunter her

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
