and before the sealing of these presents by Marinda Young (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by those presents do grant, bargain, sell and

release unto the said Marinda Young all that piece of land or lot of land
situate, lying and being in Ward No. 2, in the City of Greenville, and in
the County and State aforeswitten, and near the water of Richland
Creek, and adjoining lands of Julia Crook, Stephen Holden, and lands
formerly belonging to the estate of John W. Jones, deceased, beginning
on the, the corner of Julia Crook's lot, and running thence
one West 199 acres to stake on Stephen Holden's line, and also the
Crook's South East corner thence N. 15^o 45' E. 246 ft. to stake, Stephen
Holden's Southeast corner, thence S. 72^o E. 200 ft. to stake N. W. I. Jones
W. 12, E. 279 acres to the beginning, and containing one half
acre, more or less, and being the same lot conveyed to Wm. C. Mott
by John W. Jones, by deed bearing date the 25th day of May 1875, and

And I do hereby bind myself to any Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Marinda Young and her

Hairs and Assigns, against myself, and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
