Eshew all of my right title interest and estate of me or mine that piece, parcel and tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid on the East side of the Calhoun River and Greenville Rail Road, consisting fifty six and three fourth acres more or less, beginning on a stone on the Water Bridge Road and running thence N. 8° E. 43. 8 rods to a stone 3x3x6, on the Railroad thence N. 45; E. 19 chains to a hickory 3x3x6C, thence N. 45; E. 23 chains to a stone 3x3x6 on the road and thence down the road to the beginning being the same tract of land conveyed by John Shufeld to William M. Dalton by deed dated the fifth day of January 1859 and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County for Greenville County in book U. #78 my interest therein being derived through my mother M. A. Elizabeth Eshew who was the widow of said William M. Dalton and of ten years intermarried with my father the said Amos H. Eshew and has since died.
