and before the sealing of these presents by Greenville County, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville County, its successors and assigns, the said tract of land aforesaid, being a tract of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, beginning at a point on the East side of Laurel Creek about six miles from the City of Greenville, at or near a stone bridge, so being located over said Creek, and running thence north, southwesterly about 300 yards to The Gaines Road, the said strip, piece or parcel of land being 21 feet wide, the entire distance, and is to be used by the said County as a right of way for a public highway. The said highway being a continuation of the old Gaines Road at about one-half mile from the City of Greenville.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville County, its successors, Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind, John H. Austin, Esq., 1895, Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Greenville County, its successors,

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
