to the line of Capt. George L. Marshall. Said piece or strip of  
land being used in a change made in the extension of High  
land Avenue out side of the City limits and in feet made for  
said entire distance and so to be used by Greenwich County as  
a right of way.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any-wise incident or appertaining.
