lying and being in Pickens County Township on the County
of said State aforesaid, bearing the Sardis Flat Road, near
the Bridge crossing Mountain Creek, with running thence
in a North east direction about 400 yards crossing branch-
es of said Mountain Creek, and there forming banks
of the bottom road strip of land being the County line divide
from said distance and is to be used by Greenville County
as a right of way for a public highway, the same to be
known as Sardis Flat Road. The same
being a part of the tract of land of 89 acres conveyed to me
by T. H. Reid on Dec. 5th, 1887.
