(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said Greenville County, its successors and assigns and as
follows— All that certain piece of land aforesaid
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, the
said Greenville, S. C., and adjoining lands of H. P. Taylor. The
said piece, parcel or strip of land leaving the Marshall
Road 60 feet 20 yards from Maple Creek and running
thence South to said Creek, where a new bridge is now
being built over the said Creek. Said piece, parcel, or
strip of land being 20 feet in width at the distance aforesaid
and is for the use of the said Greenville County as a
right of way for a public highway in said County.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville County
its successors and assigns Heirs and Assigns forever.
