KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, *W. J. Thachston*  
in the State aforesaid *for and* in consideration of the sum  
of *one hundred and sixty six* Dollars to *me* in hand paid at  
and before the sealing of these presents by *Perry Beattie, James Beattie and Fanny Beattie* (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Perry Beattie, James Beattie, and Fanny Beattie* as guardians of *Emilie B. Beattie* all of my right, title and interest in *seventy three acres of land lying, situate and being in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, and having the following metes and boundaries, as shown on a plat made by J. W. Southron on October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1892:*  
*Beginning at a stake 3 x 8 x 6 M. in Kelly River, thence N. 22 1/2 E. to where the Old Iron Springs Branch crosses; thence along said crossing branch to where it empties into Kelly River; thence along the old bed of Kelly River to the beginning of this.*

*The above mentioned tract of seventy three acres is a part of a tract containing one hundred and sixty six acres in which I formerly had a one half interest, said interest being shown by deed in D. W. Stewart, Esq. Master to me dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1871. This deed is to be void, the title of said Perry Beattie, James Beattie and Fanny Beattie as guardians of Emilie B. Beattie to date seventy three acres and to give same to them. By deed of D. W. Stewart, Esq. dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1890, the said D. W. Stewart and myself prior to said last mentioned deed, having made a good division of said tract of one hundred and sixty six acres by which said D. W. Stewart was to receive seventy three acres as aforesaid, and the balance was conveyed to me.*

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said *Perry Beattie, James Beattie, and Fanny Beattie* Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind my self, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said *Perry Beattie, James Beattie, and Fanny Beattie* Heirs and Assigns, against Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
