land in the City of Greenville in the State aforesaid on the east side of Augusta
Street, having the following metes & bounds: Beginning at a stake on said street,
corner of lot no 2, thence N 88° two hundred & twenty feet to stake on line of lot no 5,
thence S 33° forty six feet to stake corner of lot no 4, thence S 88° two hundred feet
to a stake on said Augusta Street, thence along & with said Street N 27° W fifty feet to
the beginning corner, containing 10080 square feet, more or less, and designated
as lot no 3, in survey made by H P Johnson of that tract of land formerly known
as the Fairhardt property, and conveyed to William Wilkins by Anthony
Baldwin by deed bearing date of April 7th 1887.

Also an undivided one half interest in lot beginning at a stake on
the said Augusta Street forty five feet from J W Cagle corner, thence 88° two
hundred feet to a stake on line of lot No 6, thence S 33° forty one and one
half feet to a stake on said Cagles line, thence S 88° W one hundred & eighty three
