release unto the said Marshall D Earle, all that piece parcel and
tract of land situated in Greenville County in the State
of South Carolina, on both sides of the South Fork of Brushy
Creek of Reedy River, about three miles below the City
of Greenville: - Beginning at a stone 34 rods, near a
leaving pine, and running thence S 15 W 17.92 ch to
a stone in old hedge row, thence with said hedge row
S 78 E 32.50 ch to a stone 34.0 rods thence N 28 W 4.72 to a
stone 34 rods, near a Chestnut old pointy thence N 53 W
30.95 rods, to the beginning stone former, containing thirty
two and $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less being the same tract
of land conveyed to me by R H Earle and M D Earle
by their deed 30th day of October 1891, and recorded in
