TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any-wise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said A. C. Davis and her Heirs and Assigns forever.
