McGee, all that parcel and tract of land in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid about Three and a half miles from the Court House in Greenville City on the White horse road, adjoining lands of J W Ware Henry Briggs, M L Donaldson and others, having the following corners and boundaries, beginning at a stone 34 N. on the White horse road, thence N 36 E 47,40 to a Black Gum 34 N. in Long Branch, thence up Long Branch to the mouth of a small branch, thence up the small branch to a red oak 34 3/4 dead, thence S 43 1/2 E 31,69 to a stone 34 0 m, thence S 60 W 31,50 to a stone 34 a in Road, thence with the White Horse road, S 60 1/2 E 88 0 to the beginning, being the same tract of land previously to R. B. Freeman and myself by deed bearing date July 13th 1891, my interest being one half of said land. Said deed made by G. T. Willis.
