Whereas Isaac R. Greene, on September 10th, 1892, executed his promissory note to H. P. Moore, dated of that day, and thereby promised to pay to said H. P. Moore the sum of Three Hundred and seventy seven dollars and 76⁷⁶ dollars, on January 1st, 1893; and whereas the said Isaac R. Greene in order to secure the payment of said note executed his mortgage to the said H. P. Moore, dated Sept. 10th, 1892, and recorded in the R. W. C. Office for said County in Blk. C. C. page 346, and covering the premises hereinafter described; and whereas the said mortgage contained a power of sale authorizing the said H. P. Moore, in default in the payment of any part of said note, to offer the said premises at public auction and to sell the same, and on such sale to make to the purchaser a conveyance of said premises; and whereas the said note is past due and in part thereof has been paid; and whereas the said H. P.
