testament gave the whole of his real estate to his wife Elizabeth
Richardson now Barkley and his four children to wit,
J H Richardson, Mary A Peden, S M Richardson and G W
Richardson Jr, all of whom are of lawful age, Said lands
to be divided into 5 shares for the benefit of said as provided
for in said will, reference thereunto being had, will more
fully appear, Now therefore

I now all men by these Presents, That we Elizabeth
Barkley in her own right, J H Richardson, Mary A Peden
and Elizabeth Barkley as Trustee for G W Richardson Jr
in the State aforesaid in pursuance to the provisions
of said will, Do Grant in to S M Richardson and by
these presents do grant and release unto the said
S M Richardson his heirs and assigns, all of our
undivided interest in that certain piece of land
or tract of land containing twenty two and one half
(2 1/2) acres, more or less, situate and being in Good
Township in the State and County aforesaid bounded
by lands of J H Donald, S M Fowbridge and Lat No 3,
