of increasing the height of said rock dam and increase the  
height of said rock dam crossing the waters of said Emore  
River or of its affluents to overflow my said above described  
land and to cause damage to the same, and also to the crops  
which from time to time were planted and which grew and  
were growing thereon, And whereas the said The Pelham Mills  
is willing to pay me for the right and privilege of overflowing my  
said above described land the sum and price hereinafter  
named which I am willing to accept thereof,

Now therefore know all men by these presents that I  
the said B C Vaughan, for myself, my heirs executors admin-  
istrators and assigns in consideration of the premises and  
of the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars to me paid by the said The  
Pelham Mills at and before the execution and delivery  
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do  
grant bargain and sell unto the said The Pelham Mills  
successors and assigns the right and privilege of over-  
flowing my said above described land by the back water  
of said Emore River or of its said affluents caused by the  
increase of the height of said rock dam as aforesaid.

And I do hereby covenant and agree for myself my  
heirs executors administrators and assigns and all  
persons lawfully claiming or to claim by through or  
under me or any or either of us, that we will not nor  
will any or either of us make any claim whatsoever  
against the said The Pelham Mills its successors or  
assigns for any injury to the above said land, or to the  
crops planted and growing thereon from time to time  
or otherwise caused by the above said rock dam as now  
existing, and the said The Pelham Mills to whom  
such assign shall and may at all times hereafter pay  
and quietly have and hold of the said rock dam  
as now existing free from all hindrance and  
obstruction for a period of one year from the date of this  
last present.
