Whereas the Southern Railway Company
and the City Council of Greenville entered
into an agreement dated April 19th 1897
touching the change of certain streets in the City
of Greenville, which said agreement was executed
in duplicate, one part of which is now on file
with the City Clerk and Treasurer

Now, in consideration of said agreement
and to comply with the covenants therein
contained:

The Southern Railway Company grants
and dedicates for public use to the said City
Council of Greenville, its successors in
office, a right of way for the deflection of
Washington Street as shown in the blueprint
attached to said agreement, forty feet in
width, extending from Washington Street
over the lot conveyed by John Westfield to
Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway
recorded in Book E.C. page 426, in the office
of Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville
County, thence over the right of way on both
sides of the track, crossing said track at under
grade, thence across lands of Boyle and
Mauldin, thence across the south west corner
of the lot of the Company.
