made this first day of August, in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and Ninety eight  
and in the one hundred and twenty third year  
of the sovereignty and independence of the United  
States of America, between E H Marshall executive  
of the last will and testament of George W Marshall  
late of Greenville, in the County of Greenville  
and State of South Carolina, deceased, of the  
first part, and Warren B Bull of said County  
and State of the second part,

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part  
by virtue of the authority to be given me and  
by the said last will and testament, and in  
consideration of the sum of one hundred and  
four Dollars, paid by said party of the second  
part, a portion thereof to said testator, and the  
remainder to the party of the first part, at and  
before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
as granted, bargained, sold and released, and  
by these presents does grant bargain sell and  
release, unto the said party of the second part  
his heirs and assigns, forever, all the above  
right title, interest, property, possession, claim  
and demands, whatsover, both in law and  
equity, which they have or shall have in and  
upon the land

party of the first part has by virtue of the said last will  
and testament of George W Marshall, deceased, of, in  
and to all that piece parcel or tract of land in the  
County of Greenville and State of South Carolina known  
as (Marshalls Addition to the City of Greenville) Lot  
numbered seven (7) according to the map prepared  
by Mr. Southern Surveyor, on the 9th day of December  
1897, said lot being described as follows, to wit -

Beginning at a point on the north side of  
Highland Avenue one hundred and forty (140) feet  
west of the west line of Monroe Street; thence No 7 &  
two hundred and fifty eight (258) feet to the  
intersection of Lots 6 and 23; thence N 39 E  
eighty eight (88) feet to intersection of Lots 8 and  
23, thence S 57 E two hundred and fifty eight (258)  
feet to corner of lot 8, and Highland Avenue, thence  
with said Highland Avenue S 39 E eighty eight -  
(88) feet to the beginning, bounded by Highland  
Avenue and Lots numbered 6, 8 and 23, of said  
Marshalls Addition to the City of Greenville  
according to the aforesaid plat, which is recorded

first part can and ought to do pursuant  
to her authority as aforesaid.
