County and State aforesaid on the west side  
of Halls Street and known as lot No 1 of the  
division of the Samuel M Murphy property  
which was conveyed to said Murphy by two  
deeds from Wardy McFee as is recorded in the  
Office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville  
County. Said lot No 1, fronting N 20 E 60 ft on  
Halls Street and running N 40 W 126 feet back
