the interests of said school;  
And whereas it has been determined by  
said Trustees that it will be best for the  
interest of said school that the lands here-  
inafter described be sold, and the said  
lands being a portion of the land left  
by the last will and testament of Thomas  
Madaworth, deceased, for the sup-port of  
a poor school in Laurens County.  
Now, therefore, I, William Knight, Esq. Parent  
of the, William Knight in the League.  
R. P. Turner R. J. Copeland and R. C. Lewis  
Trustees of the Madaworthville Poor School  
of Laurens County, in the State aforesaid,  
for and in consideration of the sum of  
fifty five thousand, to us in hand paid  
at public before the sealing and delivery  
of this Deed, (the devisor whereof (as  
hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained  
and sold and delivered, and by other  
premises his said large tract of land, and  
all other parts of H. C. Moore his former and  
ancient property, all that poor school  
in lot of land, situate lying and being  
in the County of Laurens in the State of South  
Carolina, bounded as follows,

against us and our successors and  
assigns and the heirs and assigns  
of Thomas Madaworth, deceased, com-  
pletely claiming to to claim the same  
or any part thereof
