five miles east of the City of Gre-
nville, near Rock Mountain sometimes
called Gulch Mountain
and having the following metes,
bounds, corners and distances to-wit:
Beginning in a Maple 3x0. Then S. 49°
W. 15' to a stone 3x7. Then S. 39° E. 19' to
a stone 3x7. Then N. 30° E. 5' 9" to
a pine, 3x7. Then S. 40° E. 11' 5" to
a stone 3x7. Then N. 61° E. 1' 9" to a
stone 3x7. Then N. 46° 34' W. 17' 25" to a
stone 3x7. Then N. 18' 25" to a Poplar
3x6. Then N. 40° 12' W. 3' 15" to the beginning

more or less 3' of a safe particular
description of land which reference
