Martha Nowell (State of South Carolina, County of Greenville
Jo. S. Lind - claimant) Whereas, heretofore, my father, Ben Williams George Pool et al, late of said State and County, executed to me a fee simple deed to a certain lot of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville, in said County and State, described in said deed as follows, to wit: - Beginning at a stone 5x on Green Avenue, and running thence S 27 W 45 feet to a stone 3x, thence S 76 E 112 feet to a stone 3x, thence N 46 1/2 E 66 feet to a stone 5x, thence N 45 1/2 W 112 feet to the beginning corner said deed bearing date November 20, 1890, and being recorded December 31, 1890, in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyance, for Greenville County South Carolina, in Record Book 14, page 340.

And whereas, I subsequently executed unto W H Irvine a mortgage covering said land dated December 31, 1890, and recorded in said office in Book B.B. page 35;

And whereas, said Ben Williams subsequently paid off said mortgage to said W H Irvine, receiving both the above mentioned papers, and, being ignorant that said papers had been recorded, destroyed them both with intent to vest title to said land in himself, with my consent,

And whereas, said Ben Williams subsequently conveyed to Green Morris, George Pool and Henry Pinson certain portions of his lot of land, some of which embrace the same land heretofore described,

And whereas, I have this day executed and delivered to my sister Amelia Montgomery, a deed of conveyance to my undivided one-half interest in that certain lot of land situate on the corner of Green Avenue and St. Johns Street in the City and County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, being the only portion of land of which said Ben Williams died seized and possessed.

And whereas, it is desired by us to finally dispose of all matters connected with said real estate, and to clear the title thereof.

Now therefore, know all men by these presents that I Martha Nowell of Greenville, N.C., in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Five Dollars, to me in said paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the said Green Morris, George Pool, Henry Pinson and Amelia Montgomery (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) do hereby ratify and confirm the action of my father Ben Williams in conveying the same to me,
