situate, lying and being in Little Springs Township, Greenville County & State of S. C.  
on both sides of the Southern Ry. Way from maple Creek, waters of Saluda River. Beginning low down upon  
pin 30m, near the point where the maples cross the railroad track, and commonly known as the "Dan  
Moore Crossing" running thence  $\frac{1}{4}$  N. E. 4.20 ch. to a stone 3x0m, thence N 78 E. 38.40 chs to a willow 3x0m  
on Maple Creek; thence up the creek to a stake in the fork of the Creek; thence up the old run to a maple 3x0m  
thence N 63 W. 3.50 chs to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of Charles H. Miller, Willie Moore, James L. Miller, others
