and before the sealing of these presents by National Bank of Greenville, S. C. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said National Bank of Greenville, S. C. all right title, interest and estate  
in and to certain piece of land situate, lying and being in the County of  
Greenville and State of South Carolina, about three miles in a southwesterly direction  
from the City of Greenville, near the right of way of the Southern Railway having the  
following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone corner, and running thence  
S 18 E 400 ft. east to a stone corner, 3 x 8 x 11 in., thence S 48 E 7, 10 ch. to a stone 8 x 8 x 11 in., thence  
N 81 1/4 E 14 1/2 ch. to a pine 3 x 3 x 11 in., thence N 68 1/4 E 10 1/2 ch. to a stake or stone 3 x 4, (originally a black  
jacket,) thence N 16 1/4 E 14 1/2 ch. to a pine 8 x 8 x 11 in., thence S 81 E 10 ch. touching a poplar 3 x 8 x 11 in., (or  
or near branch) 43 1/2 ch. to beginning corner, containing twenty four (24) acres more  
or less, according to plat prepared by J. M. Boushers on Oct 29, 1880, (herewith delivered)
