This agreement entered into this the twenty-third day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine hundred and two, by and between Rosaline Phillips and Nora Williams, both of the City of Greenville, in said County and State, witnesseth:

That the said Rosaline Phillips does hereby grant and give absolutely her infant child, Savannah Wright, unto the said Nora Williams, until said infant child (who is now three years of age) shall attain the full age of twenty-one years, and for value received, does hereby absolutely dispose of the custody and tuition of the said child until the time of her coming of age, unto the said Nora Williams, according to the statutes of said State authorizing such disposal; so that neither the said Rosaline Phillips, nor anyone claiming under or through her, shall hereafter have any claim of any sort to the custody, care or earnings of said minor child, under any circumstances; And the said Nora Williams hereby covenants and agrees that she will care for said child as though it were her own, will treat it kindly, give it proper food and clothing, and educate it to the extent of her means and ability, until said child shall come of age;
