TO

SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that MONAGHAN MILLS, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-TWO AND 64/100 DOLLARS, (\$952.64) to it in hand by the party of the second part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does now grant, bargain, sell and release unto

SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Virginia, hereinafter for convenience styled the Railway Company, party of the second part,

ALL that certain strip, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being at or near GREENVILLE in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, being the right of way for an industrial spur-track which springs from the main track of the Atlanta & Charlotte Air Line Railway at a point 883.5 feet north of Milepost 487, and extending thence in a general westerly direction: (1) By a tangent 19 feet; (2) By a 14°20' curve to the right 518.5 feet; (3) By a tangent 612.5 feet; (4) by a 2° curve to the left 200 feet; (5) By a tangent 200 feet; (6) By a 12° curve to the right 486.8 feet; (7) By a tangent 443.2 feet to station 24 plus 80, being the point of connection with said spur-track of a track extending to the plant of the Union Bleaching and Finishing Company; said right of way being particularly described as a strip of land 12 1/2 feet in width on either side of the center line of said spur-track, beginning at the westerly boundary line of the right of way of said Atlanta & Charlotte Air Line Railway, 100 feet west of the center line therof, that is to say, at station 3 plus 30 on said spur-track; thence following the alignment of said spur-track as located and constructed, and having a uniform width of twenty five (25) feet, for a distance of 2150 feet to station 24 plus 80 on said spur-track; ALL being substantially as shown upon blue-print hereto annexed and made a part of this indenture.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said strip of land, together with the appurtenances, and all singular the right, title and interest of the party of the first part, of whatsoever nature and description, in and to or concerning the same, unto the Railway Company, its successors and assigns, forever; the party of the first part hereby specifically releasing unto the Railway Company, its successors and assigns, any right to in any manner control or restrict the operations of the Railway Company upon and over said spur-track extending between the point of connection thereof with the said Atlanta & Charlotte Air Line Railway main track and the point of switch of said spur-track extending to the said plant of the Union Bleaching and Finishing Company, for the benefit of other persons or corporations than the party of the first part.

And the PARTY OF THE FIRST PART Hereby binds itself, its successors and assigns, to warrant and defend, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the Railway Company, its successors and assigns, against the party of the first part, its successors and assigns, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
