(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said J. W. Burton All that certain lot of land situated in said  
County and State in ward 2 of the City of Greenville, on the South  
side of Ann Street, with following lines and metes: Beginning at  
Door Step on Ann Street corner Mountains City and Improvement  
Company, thence with Davis Street 3 1/2 x 10 7/8 feet to iron pins my  
corner, thence with my line 3 1/2 x 6 1/2 feet to iron pins corner myself,  
thence with line more or less M. M. Hollis 11 7/8 x 8 7/8 feet to iron pins corner  
Mt. City and Co., so thence with line of said company 11 1/2 x 6 1/2 feet to  
beginning, containing 4608 square feet more or less, according to plan made  
by J. W. Burton, D. S. on September 30th 1894, Being part of a lot surveyed  
to me by Mountains City and Improvement Company on May 18th 1878

claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
