 release unto the said Davis W. Hodges, his heirs and assigns forever All that piece parcel  
tract of land situate lying and being in Caluda Township, County of Greenville,  
and State of South Carolina, and having the following number and bounds to wit:  
Beginning at a stone on North side of Hodges Mill Creek; corner of Humphreys  
Branch; thence N. 48° 37' E. 10. 9. 75 ch. to a stake;  
thence S. 87° 10. 6. 10 chains to a maple on branch; thence N. 28° 8. 16. 10 chains to the  
beginning corner containing four (4) acres and one-third acre, more or less, and lying  
on both sides of the said Hodges Mill Creek; on which is situated the Herring Pond;

 release unto the said Thomas J. Potter and Timm O. Potter, their heirs and assigns forever.

All our right, title and interest in and to all that piece parcel and tract of land  
 situated, lying and being in Greenville County and State of Greenville on both sides of  
 Gap Creek, and having the following lines, poles and bounds viz:

Beginning at a poplar on the North side of a branch, and on the east side of  
 the Gap Creek Road, and run up and with the said branch 20. 80 to a chestnut  
 3x10 (down) near the head of the branch, thence d. N. 0. 5. 00 to a chestnut oak, 3x10 (down),
