All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, containing 7/100 of one acre, more or less, situate, lying and being on the North side of the Farr Bridge Road, in the County and State aforesaid, about two and one half miles from the City of Greenville, and described as follows: Beginning at a stake 3x4 m. on north side of said Farr Bridge Road, said Thomas Springfield's south west corner, and running thence with his line N. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 210 feet to a stake 3x4 m.
