 home place of said Marchbanks and formerly known as the Hillhouse tract, said tract having
 been resurveyed Oct. 27-1801 by W. A. Budson A.S. and the following endorsement made on plat surveyed
 and laid off Two hundred and thirty acres of land, both sides of the Pincombe Road, eight
 miles from Greenville C. & R. and east side of Little Texas Road, as per survey of John Gilmore,
 dated April 26th 1836 taken from his note of said date, Little Texas Road line surveyed by me
 Oct. 29, 1801, said tract having the following mate and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone
 where the Old Hillhouse line crossed the Little Texas Road thence with Little
 Texas Road 3.70 chaines to bend, thence continuing with said Little Texas Road
