Barr of Greenville County (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George T. Barr,

All that lot or parcel of land lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, situated on the west side of Main Street in the said City and beginning at an iron stake at the corner of John A. Russell's lot and running with said parties line from Main Street N. 70 3/4 W. 201 feet to an iron stake on an alley or lane thence with said lane N. 18 1/2 E. 67- sixty seven feet to an iron stake, thence S. 70 3/4 E. two hundred and three--203- feet to an iron stake on Main Street, thence with said street and having a front thereon sixty seven--67--feet to the beginning corner in all containing one third of an acre more or less, bounded by lands of Jno. H. Russell, Lewis W. Parker and Mamie S. Barr and being marked on a plat made of said lands bought by Lewis W. Parker of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and Julia S.
