Harrison,

All those three tracts of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, to-wit:

1st. That piece or parcel of land, beginning on...on waters of South Pacolet River, thence to a Spanish Oak on the old line, thence nearly south with the Mill Road to a rock on the conditional line to the beginning, containing twenty five acres, more or less. The same being a part of the lines laid off by Jacob to me.
