McBee homestead, and by him devised to Mrs. Harriet Butler McBee for life and then to his children, Frank Butler McBee, Vardry Echols McBee, Malinda P. McBee and Emilia Louisa McBee, reference being had to the Will of W.P. McBee, dated Oct. 1st. 1860, and recorded in Office of Probate Judge for Greenville County, Vol. D. pages 257 & 258 will more fully show. Said lots represented on a plat made by J.N. Southern D.S.
