in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and Fifty Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M. T. Lee

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said M. T. Lee all that certain piece of land situated in the State of South Carolina, on the west side of the Wadsworth Road, about one eighth mile from the corporate limit of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning near state 20 on the Wadsworth Road and running thence N. 32° 40' E. 336 ft. to a rock; thence S. 53° E. 1164 ft. to a state 20 on the said Andovers Road; thence along said road N. 58° 56' E. 100 ft. to the beginning corner, containing one acre and 96^{1/4} acres, more or less, being by survey of these two lots of land conveyed, first, by George H. Jenkins, by Deed of Court-yealde bearing date December 5, 1784 and recorded at the Office of the Register of Deeds County of Greenville County on Decr. 5, 1784, page 275.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said M. T. Lee his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said M. T. Lee.

Heirs and Assigns, against all and singular Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
