(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. L. Davis All that piece, place, and lot of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina on Bishop Street, known as lot 10 of the Standard, according to a plat made by J. H. Morrison January 25, 1891, and having the following metes and bounds; Beginning at corner of lot 10, 8 feet long, being 8.28 x 9.00 feet to lot 11; thence S. 67° E. 1.25 chains to a post there N. 23° E. 2.45 chains to lot 10, thence N. 75° E. 10.105 chains to the beginning corner. This is the lot upon which Margaret Johnson now resides, and the same was owned by Martha Green January 31, 1891, died a widow in Office of Probate of Greenville County, in Book F, X, Page 603 and the same was willed to Frank C. Davis by said Margaret Johnson by will dated December 24, 1901, recorded in Book D. J. S. Page 406. And by Frank C. Davis conveyed to C. L. Davis December 10th, 1903, died record in Book F. S. S. Page 149, and by C. L. Davis conveyed to me December 3rd, 1903, record in Book F. S. S. Page 180.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said C. L. Davis, his

Heirs and Assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
