Pagwell, All that tract of Land lying in Franklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing Fifty Acres, more or less, and having the following metes bounds and boundaries, to wit: Beginning on a stone post corner on lands of Gott, Gregg, Heney North 30, 2, 6, 15, 9 State Hill bounded by Robt. Gregg's land, thence \$80 E, 33, 12 to a rock hill bounded by the boundary of the Myrons first, thence S, 23 E, 9, 2, 1, 9 Sweet Creek on one creek bounded by Robt. Carter's land, thence down said creek, thence W, 0, 0 E, 1, 3, 0 to 9 rods 1000 feet from the point of beginning, bounded by lands of J. L. Barnwell.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. D. Pagwell, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. D. Pagwell, his Heirs, and against every

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
