(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Laura G. Parker, certain tract or parcel of land situated in Glaxy Mountain Township, County and State of South Carolina, to wit by the Rd. of Glaxy Mountain, on the day of Aug 1890, having the following metes and bounds on Brown Creek, waters of South Pacolet, beginning on a double tract copy line 37, running thence N. 8° 10' East 70 poles to a post in 37 N. 14' East 80 poles to a Spanish Oak 37, thence N. 29 East three poles to a ditch, thence N. 68 West 100 poles and thence with N. 68 West to Jessie Wilson's corner, thence with N. 28 East along Carlton and Turner Road to a chestnut tree near Colan 37, below the Catt Grove Baptist Church, running thence west of the church and across yard lot to the Oak Grove Road, running thence about eastward and back to the beginning corner containing fifty acres, more or less, of land of Bill Umley Henry Belue, and others.
