of land or lot of land situated lying and being in Greenville County aforesaid containing one and one half (1 1/2)
acres or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 6 ft. from a stone 3 ft.
E. 47° to a stone by Black Burn 3 ft.; thence N. 62° E. 31' to a stone 3 ft.; thence S. 27° E. 47° to a stone 3 ft.;
thence S. 62° E. 10.31 ft. to the beginning stone, enclosing the sum total of forty (40) acres to me by my
father Ed. McCloud, by deed bearing date November 1st, 1891, and recorded in P.M.C. Office for Dauphin
