Goddard*, all that piece, parcel and tract of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and Oxford Township, containing one hundred and ten (10) acres more or less, and having the following lines and bounds and corners and distances to wit: Beginning at a stone a.m. thence S. 43° 16' 7.5" to stone N.W. thence N. 40° 10' 31.70" to stone N.W. thence N. 35° 11' 12.00" to stone N.W. thence N. 44° 53' 0.4" to White Oak Head and down, thence N. 55° 2.2' 6.00" to Hickory Creek and creek front of road, thence N. 70° 6' 7.25" to stone a.m. thence S. 11° 35' 6.90" to the beginning, and bounded by lands of *George W.
