Howell on the East lands of Cora C. Howell and Geo. Cunningham, on the South lands of Geo Cunningham and Estate of P.D. Green, on the West lands of Estate of P.D. Green and lands of Cora C. Howell, being a portion of lands purchased by Cora C. Howell from B.A. Green, said lands recorded in two separate tracts Vol. C.C.C. pg 281 and Vol. B.B.B. pg 15, Containing Thirty five Acres more or less and is more particularly described by course and distances as follows, Beginning at a stone 3xnm, in Mrs Cora C.
