And I do hereby bind myself, my wife, Mary, Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. B. Hughes and Mary Ann Hughes, their

Heirs and Assigns, against World and Mary, Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
