(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Ashmore All that tract or parcel of land lying within and situated in County and State aforesaid, the same being a part of tract of land conveyed to me by deed on the 6th day of January 1905, by Andrew Cope, and described as follows: Beginning at stone No. 1, C of corner land thence N. 73° E. 16.00 to stone 39 and thence N. 21° W. 2.56 to stone thence N. 42. W. 120.0 to stone thence S. 24° E. 1.82 to stone thence S. 34° E. 1.175 to stone thence S. 32° W. 2.25 to beginning corner containing twenty four and 1/4 acres more less, and bounded by lands of Mr. Rhodes, Cope and others.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

John Ashmore his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said John Ashmore.

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
