All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate in the State and County aforesaid Greenville Township, and known as lots 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99 and 100, of survey of W. F. Lee, June 3, 1903. Containing five and 54/100 acres, more or less, between Goldsmith St. and Southern Railway, bounded by Goldsmith St., Henry St., Southern Railway track and David St., subject to right of way of Southern Railway. Also all that other piece, parcel or tract of land, comprehending lots 137, 138, 139 & 140, on the east side of the old Paris Mountain road and both sides of the Southern Railway, containing four and 59/100 acres more or less, including the right of way of the Southern Railway, and nearly over half a rail road bridge.
