All that lot or tract of land lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid and on branch waters of Durbin Creek being lot No 3 of the Thomason Est. according to a survey made by J. A. Adams and contains forty acres more or less and hath the following metes and bounds to wit: bounded by J. M. Richardson's lot No 3 and Stage Road commencing on a stone on Stage Road near the residence of Mrs. Alice Brooks, running thence N. 41 3/4 W. 266 to a stone 3 X thence N. 57 3/4 E. 6.34 to a stone in Stage Road thence N. 5 E. 47.80 to a stone on J. M. Richardson's line thence S. 66 E. 8.60 to a stone 3X thence S. 52 W. 48.80 to beginning corner.
