South Carolina, of the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
sell and release unto the said The Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of  
Odd Fellows of the State of South Carolina all that certain  
parcel of land, in said County and State on the Bailey Bridge  
road known as the Carpinter Vineyard, containing seventy two and  
one half acres, more or less, and also all that other tract  
of land adjoining the aforesaid tract beginning at a stake and  
extending thence N. 47 1/4 W. 12. 87 to a pine thence S. 13. E. 11. 10 to a stump  
thence N 77 1/4 E. 7. 40 to the beginning corner containing four acres  
more or less and being a part of Carpinter Vineyard, being the  
same two lots of land conveyed by D. G. Verner, Master to  
W. H. Beattie, on December 21, 1889, recorded in R. M. C. office,  
said County and State, Book U. V. Page 43.

ever.

and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said The Grand Lodge of the  
Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of South Carolina  
Heirs and Assigns, against us and our Heirs, and against every  
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
