in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand

Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

C. C. Bearder of County and State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. C. Bearder, District, pieces, parcels and tracts of land situate

lying and lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, no or not lying and being in the  
 and in the valley of Etasha Thompson's Branch Draw Creek, one of Middle Tyger River  
 on the east side of the road leading from Greenville, S. C. to Rutherfordton, N. C. Beginning at a stone in said  
 road or runs S. 30 E. 750 feet W. C. near a Spring known before said Spring branch with its  
 meanders to a maple, 3 X 3 X Thence S. 48 E. 26.40 to a maple 3 X 3 X in an other branch, known as said  
 branch, with the meanders to an ash 3X on the Greenville Rutherfordton road, then with said road  
 the beginning, containing twenty-nine acres more or less, being same tract of land conveyed to  
 James G. Bowes by the T. Justice on 31st of Dec 1881 & recorded in Book 17, page 228, also a tract 118.2,  
 Beginning at a black Oak 3X 3X near the Rutherfordton road, near a small branch, and at corner of  
 the James Morgan lands and run westward thence N. 71 E. W. 16.87 to a chestnut 3X on Butler's line fence P. 1-Ex. 80  
 to black gum 3X Thence S. 84 E. 6.9 to the red Oak 3X Thence S. 49 E. 22.50 then to a stone on side of Ruth-  
 erfordton road and back 3X in the aforesaid branch thence S. 19 W. 70 direct to the beginning and  
 contains forty acres, more or less, being tract no 2, County of S. C. Bowes, by the T. Justice Dec 31 1881, also tract  
 7.5 Beginning at a stone on Rutherfordton road and run with said road back to a stone 3X Thence S. 42 W. 13.00 back to  
 Black Oak 3X Thence S. 36 E. 14.00 to a stone 3X Thence S. 47 E. 3.00 to the beginning and containing twenty-nine acres, and fifty nine rods  
 more or less, being tract 170.9 conveyed to J. E. Bowes by the T. Justice, on Dec. 31st 1881, also tract 7.5 Beginning at a stone  
 with Rutherfordton road and run with said road 46.4 E. 7.00 back to a stone, Thence S. 47 E. 21.00 back to a stone 3X  
 on the branch, then up the branch until the meanderings of same to W. C. 3X near a Spring known as S. 47 E. W. 70  
 then to the beginning and containing ten acres more or less, being same tract of land conveyed to J. E. Bowes by R. F. Whalen  
 on 29th Dec 1884 recorded in book 18, page 197 in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County containing in all the  
 four tracts described One hundred & one acre, & fifty nine rods

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or  
 in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the  
 said C. C. Bearder, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said C. C. Bearder, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every  
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
