 and having the following metes, corners, and boundaries viz: Beginning at a stone 3x6 in the road
 with William and Anna Cuffe, running thence along said road a line S. 86° 11' 53" E.
 running thence S. 86° 11' 53" E. 281 ft. to a stone S. 19° 34' W. 465 ft. to a stone
 thence S. 19° 34' W. 365 ft. to a stone S. 19° 34' W. 265 ft. to a stone S. 19° 34' W. 339
 ft. to a stone 3x6 in the road, thence S. 43° 40' 20" to a stone 3x6 in said Bush Creek where
 it joins the river with the cornering 2.10 ft. to stone 3x6 in, originally a Red Oak in front of creek
 4.00 ft. from the corner 11.31 ft. 0.125 ft. 00. in the beginning adjoining lands of Butler Williams were

 more or less, the same being conveyed to me by W. F. Whitmire on 28 Nov 1896 on record in the
 office of R. M. C. in Vol. P. B. B. page 546 for a full description of the miles and boundaries
 referred to here to make Also all that piece of land in western part of Greenville Township in County
 and State aforesaid, about 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles from Greenville City containing 2 acres more or less, this being
 the same piece of land conveyed to me by W. F. Whitmire on Jan 3rd, and recorded in the Office
 of R. M. C. Vol. 1, P. B. B. page 370 the four conveyances above described are all
