(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. R. Neely, all that piece of land

in Greenville County, State of South Carolina near the incorporated  
 limits of the City of Greenville, about two miles from the Court House  
 on the west side of the Barncombe road and known as Lot No 207  
 of the land conveyed to me by S. M. Snider as shown on a plat made  
 by W. H. Gladsome, and bounded as follows: beginning at an iron pin  
 in Barncombe Road, 204 feet from the south side of Marlin Street and  
 running thence S 13° E. 84 1/2 feet to an iron pin in said road;  
 then westerly with line of lot No 206 two hundred and four feet to a  
 stone; thence with line of lot No 213, eighty-six feet to a stake; thence  
 easterly with line of lot No 208, two hundred and four feet to the  
 beginning corner. For a further description see said plat and deed from  
 said S. M. Snider to me recorded in Office of Register of Deeds Conveyance  
 in Book "M. M." Page 372.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said

W. R. Neely, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
