Merchant's corner on Emma Street and runs thence S 19° W 204 feet to spike, thence N 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 115 feet and 9 inches to iron spike thence N. 19° E. 204 feet to spike on Emma Street thence S 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 114 feet and 4 inches to the beginning and containing 54/100 of an acre bounded on the North by Emma street on the East by R. S. Merchant on the south and West by lands of Emma A. Westmoreland.
