in consideration of the sum of One Hundred
 Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 Leola A. Watson, of said City, County and State
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
 sell and release unto the said Leola A. Watson, all that certain lots, pieces
 or parcels of land situate lying and being in the
 State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Greenville
 Township just west of the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville.
 Known and designated as lot number three (3) on a plat prepared
 by H. G. Hudson, bearing date December 30, 1904, and having the following
 angles and boundaries, according to said plat, to wit: Beginning
 at a stake on the north side of old road which was formerly a
 continuation of West Street (now Hampton Avenue) two hundred
 and forty-five (45) feet from the center of the main line track of Southern
 Railway Company and running thence N. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. One Hundred and
 eighty-four (84) feet to a stake on line of Mrs. Nancy Johnson's
 property line, then due west line N. 68 W. Sixty-six (66) feet to a stake
 thence S. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. One Hundred and fifty-one (51) feet to a stake on
 the north side of said old road; thence S. 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. along said old
 road sixty-five (65) feet to the beginning corner, containing
 10,664 square feet more or less, and being a part of the tract
 of land conveyed unto me, the said T. A. Bellotte, by
 Mrs. Nancy Johnson, by deed bearing date January 8, 1908
 and not yet recorded.

 and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said

Leola A. Watson, and her
 Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my
 Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
